2021 New Mexico Pinot Gris

100% Pinot Gris

This wine was kept in stainless & was bottled relatively young to preserve freshness. Enjoy the classic ripe apple & pear core of this wine, which is accompanied by accents of wet wool, Marcona almonds & a light hint of nutmeg.

2021 New Mexico Gewürztraminer

100% Gewürztraminer

Loaded with spicy & exotic flavor. Aromas ranging from lychee & red roses to apricot & honeydew melon. Barrel fermentation gives notes of hazelnut & almond along with a subtle brioche.

2021 Dos Padres Roussanne

100% Roussanne

Pear, red-delicious apple, minerals, sea salt & almond sliver are a few of the interesting characters this wine presents us. Try holding on to this for 2-3 years to allow some of the honey & jasmine to develop.

COMBO FLIGHT

2021 Piquette de Counoise Rosa

100% Counoise

This refreshing wine was created in a style known in France as “Piquette”. Unlike our other wines, this was bottled very young with a bit of pétillance or sparkle. Piquette is often enjoyed while working in the vineyards because its brisk acidity & fizz are invigorating & restorative.

2021 Painted Lady Gewürztraminer

100% Gewürztraminer

This fruit comes to us from the Painted Lady Vineyard in Skull Valley, Arizona. A bit riper than previous vintages, this Gewürztraminer has beautiful green melon, white lily, quince, asian pear and mineral driven characteristics.

This wine is pure pink grapefruit – so much so that it evokes the classic tequila drink, the Paloma. This wine is all about summer and if you love freshness, focus and purity... this rosé is for you. Aged four & a half months in stainless steel.

RED FLIGHT

2020 Colibri Grenache Pick 2

100% Grenache

Despite Colibri vineyard's high elevation and cooler climate relative to our other vineyards, warming trends in recent years have diminished the overt pepperiness of these wines. This wine has classic Arizona Grenache characters including wild strawberry, red raspberry, hints of peach and light citrus notes. Enjoy while young and fresh!

2021 Mules Mistake

43% Grenache, 31% Syrah, 24% Mourvèdre,
2% Counoise

We think of Mule's as PSC's Pinot stand in: red fruit driven, light to medium bodied and infinitely drinkable. As Mule's has evolved, so has our approach to crafting it. Now in its 12th year, all of the juiciness and bright red fruits combine as a - light, refreshing summer drinker.

2020 Colibri Mourvèdre Pick 2

100% Mourvèdre

Harvested a little later and slightly riper than other Mourvèdre picks in 2020... this bottling highlights the richer, darker fruit profile of black raspberry, plum and mulberries with lighter spice but just as much earthiness.

2017 Vino De La Familia Blanca

91% Malvasia Bianca, 9% Vidal Blanc

White wine for the family! With Malvasia's historical viticultural origins in Turkey, this liquid landscape is both ancient & new, simple yet complex. The Malvasia from this year's bottling comes from our own Dos Padres Vineyard in Northern Arizona! Enjoy the waves of pineapple, mandarin, muskmelon, white lilies, & honeysuckle with an open mind & thoughts of high elevation in Arizona.

2017 House Mountain Grenache Whole Cluster

100% Grenache

Our third harvest from this unique vineyard continues to showcase the site. This little planting of Grenache, less than an acre, juts out below the higher volcanic flanks of House Mountain which loom overhead. The soils are pure limestone and their opalescent gleam can be seen from miles away. Everything about this site oozes of terroir and so does this wine. This small batch had a significant portion of the stems left in which has brought more structure and rusticity to the wine but still expresses the intense, classic wild strawberry of this stunning vineyard block.

100% Syrah

The lean granitic soils of Colibri Vineyards in the Chiricahua Mountains of southeastern Arizona produce some of the most distinctive and interesting Syrahs we make. Clones 174 and 474 are grown adjacent to one another on the upper slopes of Colibri – and while the soils and ecological conditions are nearly identical, these genetic differences create noticeable variations in these wines. As in the past, the 474 showed strongly in our cellar and this small quantity had to be bottled pure. With dark, concentrated fruit, spice, leather, and impeccable balance, this wine ranks among the best we have produced.

APPLE FLIGHT

2021 Arizona Sparkling Apple Wine

100% Apple

Apple wines, like grape wines, are all about sourcing. This cuvee was crafted from apples grown in three orchards: Apple Annie's from Southern Arizona, our own Estate, & Hidden Valley Ranch found just upstream from our winery. With apples ranging from Pink Lady, Granny Smith, Winesaps & Black Arkansas, this special blend of varieties brings freshness & balance to the wine. Pure essence of apple hits you on the nose & follows with tingly, juicy, crisp apple on the palate. It's like biting into a fresh apple with a special gift given to us by the divine hands of yeast & time.

2021 Cochise Granny Smith

100% Apple

Originally grown by its namesake Maria Ann "Granny" Smith in Australia in the 1860s, this apple is firm with a light green skin & a crisp, juicy flesh. A very popular apple (3rd in the US) where it is the choice apple for baking & cooking. This wine is the most structured of the bunch from 2021, with a bright straw color with a greenish tinge, showcasing refreshing tart apple candy flavors.

2021 Yavapai County Apple Blend

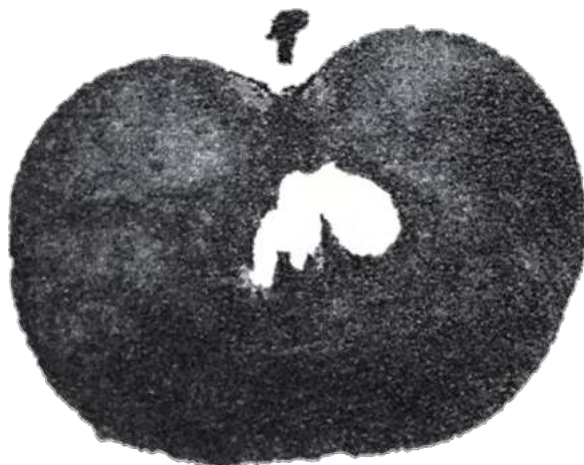
100% Apple

2019 House Mountain Pinot Noir

100% Pinot Noir

Pinot's homeland of Burgundy, France is cooler than many of our growing regions so we have sought out cool microclimates to grow this fickle grape in. The ripeness level of the Pinot is spot on: it's not too high leading the alcohol to dominate and seem hot, but not too low and lacking on body. The "pinosity" is all there with wonderful Bing cherry, rhubarb, orange peel, bramble and a light earthy spice. And, of course, the texture is soft and silky. Whabamn!

2019 Colibri Syrah Clone 474

100% Syrah

The lean granitic soils of Colibri Vineyards in the Chiricahua Mountains of southeastern Arizona produce some of the most distinctive and interesting Syrah's we make. Clones 174 and 474 are grown adjacent to one another on the upper slopes of Colibri – and while the soils and ecological conditions are nearly identical, these genetic differences create noticeable variations in these wines. This clone and block are consistent performers gracing us with classic, northern Rhone styled wines annually. If you have the time, allow this to age for a few years and compare it to Rhone wines from St. Joseph, Cornas or Hermitage and enjoy PSC at a fraction of the price.

2020 Colibri Syrah 174

100% Syrah

In 2010 the Colibri Syrah Clone 174 became one of two wines from Arizona that broke the Wine Spectator 90-point barrier for the first time (the other was a Colibri Syrah Clone 99!). Year-in, year-out, this block produces the most rustic, classically old-world Syrah in our whole portfolio. This clone gives us classic black cherry and blackberry as well as loads of fresh potting soil, flint, ash, and dark green herbs. The beauty of this wine is that it is not top heavy in any way: the weight, alcohol, and tannins all balance in a perfect trinity. If you like classic Syrah from the Rhone, this is your wine!

2019 House Mountain Syrah 525 Co-Ferment

92% Syrah, 8% Malvasia Bianca

House Mountain Vineyard can be found about one mile upstream from our Estate. A collaboration between Page Springs and the Petznick family of the Dancing Apache Ranch, this nine-acre site is planted to several varieties, with the biggest block being Syrah clones 471 and 525. The grapes on this site are receiving more heat and these hill-slopes see more constant wind and thus appear to have less threat of fungal issues. This co-ferment, meaning the white and red grapes were fermented together, not blended, is based on the northern Rhone Cote Rotie concept of fermenting Viognier and Syrah. In our case, Malvasia is the white counterpart and brings a wonderful floral, stone fruit quality to the wine while also tempering the tannins and leading to a beautiful, soft finish.

2019 House Mountain Teroldego

100% Teroldego

This is our sixth vintage bottling single varietal Teroldego from House Mountain Vineyard. This nine-acre site is planted to several varieties, with Teroldego being one of the first to ripen each year. With origins in northern Italy up near the borders of Switzerland and Austria, this grape is well adapted to our cold winters and wetter late-summers and early fall. This is a seriously tannic, age-worthy wine loaded with dense, dark fruits, tar, tobacco, baker's chocolate and a hint of molasses.

SPECIALTY WINE

2021 Vin De Filles

93% Syrah, 7% Malvasia Bianca

This unique wine was made by Arizona women to highlight the vitality and feminine strength within the world of wine. We co-fermented House Mountain Syrah and Dos Padres Malvasia Bianca, similar in style to a Cote Rotie. Aromas of cacao nib and blood orange tickle our noses while we reflect on our playfulness in the vineyard. Our palates discover black cherry and cassis mingling with raw honey and wildflowers, a seriousness that aligns with our time in the cellar. These traits mimic the vibrant community of women who have come together to create this wine. *Net profits will be donated to the Verde Valley Sanctuary, a local non-profit organization that provides support for victims of domestic violence and sexual assault.*

SPARKLING WINE

2020 Blanc De Noir Méthode Champenoise

60% Pinot Noir, 40% Chardonnay

We are working with Nostra Vita Family Winery in Lodi California to produce 3 different sparkling wines. These sparkling wines are now being produced by our new partner under our name. PSC bubbles! This Blanc De Noir exhibits earthy and complex aromas of ripe white peach, guava and underripe strawberries with a subtle autolytic, biscuity edge. The rich palate has a balance of red and white stone fruits highlighted with wet stone minerality and a slight bitter finish of red grapefruit rind.

Now in its 12th year as an Arizona blend, all of the juiciness and bright red fruits you’ve come to love combine as a light, refreshing summer drinker.
